LUKOIL AND VLADIMIR REGION SIGNED A COOPERATION AGREEMENT

A Cooperation Agreement was signed today in Vladimir by the Governor of Vladimir region Nikolai Vinogradov and LUKOIL's President Vagit Alekperov.

The parties agreed in particular to develop their cooperation in oil products delivery to the industrial and agricultural enterprises, municipal economy enterprises and social-oriented enterprises, in building and reconstruction of oil bases, filling stations, in transportation, wholesale and retail trade of oil products.

The company will also, through its subsidiary enterprise OAO "LUKOIL-Vladimirnefteproduct", build in 2002 three petroleum stations, two gas-oriented filling stations and one filling complex on the territory of the Vladimir oblast.
