PRESIDENT OF LUKOIL AND GOVERNOR OF NENETS AUTONOMOUS  
DISTRICT DISCUSS PROSPECTS FOR COOPERATION

President of LUKOIL Vagit Alekperov and Governor of the Nenets Autonomous District Igor Koshin have met in Moscow today to review results of cooperation in 2016 and discuss the participation of the Company in some future projects in the region.

In 2016, under the Social Partnership Agreement, LUKOIL financed the 3rd Arctic Music Festival "Days of Classical Music in the Arctic" and construction of the first skate park in Naryan-Mar, capital of the District.
