LUKOIL AND ADMINISTRATION OF NENETS AUTONOMOUS OKRUG SIGN AGREEMENT ON COOPERATION

Vagit Alekperov, OAO LUKOIL President, and Igor Koshin, Governor of the Nenets Autonomous Okrug, signed a cooperation agreement between the company and NAO, in Naryan-Mar today, for the period till December 31, 2019.

Under the agreement, the parties will continue interaction in such areas as geological exploration, production of oil and gas, development of the petroleum-product supply system and of the production and social infrastructures, as well as in other areas of mutual interest.
