LUKOIL WORKERS GIVEN STATE, MINISTERIAL AND CORPORATE  
AWARDS ON COMPANY 25TH ANNIVERSARY

Official awards ceremonies took place in Moscow today on the occasion of LUKOIL's 25th anniversary with state, ministerial and corporate awards given to LUKOIL Group employees.

In the Kremlin, Head of the RF President Administration Anton Vaino conveyed through LUKOIL President Vagit Alekperov the acknowledgement of President Putin to the company employees.
