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LUKOIL AND TULA REGION SIGN COOPERATION AGREEMENT

President of LUKOIL Vagit Alekperov and the Governor of Tula Region Alexey Dyumin signed the Agreement on Social and Economic Cooperation for the next five years at the Saint Petersburg International Economic Forum today.

According to the agreement, the company will contribute to regional agenda, intended to raise efficiency of the fuel and energy complex, develop road infrastructure, preserve social peace, improve environmental situation and guarantee supplies of petroleum and petrochemical products to individuals and businesses.

In its turn, the Government of the Tula Region confirmed that it would assist the company with reconstruction of existing facilities for transportation, storage and marketing of petroleum and petrochemical products, and will help develop the filling stations chain.

Information:

Sales of petroleum products are LUKOIL's main business in the Tula Region. The company marketed 122 thousand metric tons of petroleum products in 2018. The daily average of products sold by LUKOIL's local chain of twenty six retail stations is thirteen tons. The population of the region is 1.5 million people. Its fleet is 700 thousand vehicles.
