LUKOIL AND EMERCOM OF RUSSIA CONCLUDE COOPERATION AGREEMENT

Russian Minister for Civil Defence, Emergencies and Elimination of Consequences of Natural Disasters Evgeniy Zinichev and President of LUKOIL Vagit Alekperov had a meeting today at the XIII*International Integrated Safety & Security Exhibition 2021*. They signed an Agreement on Cooperation in Ensuring Fire Safety and Protecting Population and Territories against Natural and Technological Emergencies.

The parties agreed to cooperate on a range of issues, including interlinking of emergencies monitoring and forecasting systems, joint exercises and trainings on technological emergencies and fires prevention and response at the facilities of LUKOIL and its subsidiaries.
