LUKOIL AND WORLD WILDLIFE FUND SIGN ROADMAP FOR 2017

LUKOIL and the World Wildlife Fund (WWF) have approved a joint plan of actions for 2017, as part of a cooperation agreement. The roadmap was signed by Gleb Ovsyannikov, Head of Public Relations at LUKOIL, and Alexey Knizhnikov, WWF-Russia's Head of Program on the Fuel and Energy Complex's Environmental Policies. The event took place at a roundtable discussion, "Small Indigenous Groups of the North: Interaction with Industrial Corporations. Environmental and Social Responsibility", held at the Public Chamber of the Russian Federation.

Also delivered at the roundtable was a presentation on the interaction between LUKOIL and the indigenous population of the North. A corporate brochure, "Preserving Traditions of the North", was presented.
